2. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All-IBSA member federations, coaches and athletes participating in the event described in these outlines have to respect and accept the authority of the IBSA officials, the IBSA Statutes & rules, the IJF Sports an Organization Rules (SOR), the IBSA Refereeing Rules and IJF Code of Ethics. Individuals deemed to have acted against the above-mentioned rules, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

All judokas have to possess an IBSA ISAS code. From 1st January 2015 all IBSA athletes must be registered on the IBSA Sport Administration System (ISAS).

3. INSURANCE

Each IBSA member Federation (in the following: IBSA Member Organizations) is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the control of gender are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials during the event described in these outlines.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above-mentioned matters. Nevertheless, the IBSA Members Organizations staging the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA have no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and travelling in connection with this event.

6. ACCOMMODATION

7. PAYMENT

All payment should be made in cash upon arrival

8. VISA

The organizer is happy to help any country to obtain a visa for athletes and officials. For nations, who need a visa to enter the organizing country, please send a full list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth, and positions along with scanned copies of all passports before the deadline stipulated.

Visa Application Deadline: 1 March 2019

9. COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR, IJF & IBSA judo refereeing Rules, IJF Code of ethics and actual Anti-Doping Rules.

System of competition: double repechage or round robin (it depends on the number of participants)

Weight Categories: Individual Competition (**No Team Competition planned**)

Men: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Women: -57kg,+70kg

Duration of Contest: Men 4 minutes and Women 4 minutes (real time)

10. REFEREEING

The contest will be refereed by Continental and/or International Referees.

The referees will use **CARE** system.

11. INSCRIPTION OF DELEGATES

Competitors can only be entered in one category and only entries of IBSA member national judo federations will be accepted. Participating athletes must be 15 years in the calendar year.

Each national federation can inscribe **a maximum two (2) athletes per weight category.** The Organizer may allow three (3) athletes per weight category as the hosting nation.

12. ATHELETES' ELIGIBILITY

Please note that all athletes must comply with the following conditions before being accepted to the event.

- IBSA Athlete License for the current year or 2019.
- Paid IBSA Membership fees for the current year or 2019.
- Participating athletes must be born 2003 (15 years in the calendar year).
- The all judokas must wear **White Judogi (No Blue Judogi allowed to wear).**

13. EYE CLASSIFICATION

No Eye Classification to be conducted at this Championships.

14. DRAW

Each participating Organization must send at least one delegate to attend the draw. A maximum of three delegates per federation will be authorized.

15. JUDO GI CONTROL

Athletes must compete wearing **an IJF approved Judogi** supplied by one of the following manufacturers.

Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, DANROH, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Film, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURI B.V, KAPPA, DAEDO.

The judokas have to wear a judogi with a back number. The judoka who does not wear a back number on her or his judogi **will be disqualified.**

The back number will be prepared and provided by the local organizer before the competition.

16. WEIGH-IN

The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF SOR section 7 and the IJR.

17. COACHING

Coaches nominated by their IBSA Members should respect the IBSA Judo Regulation Code of Ethics. Any coaches not adhering these rules could be subject to disciplinary action.
