



Minimum requirements for IBSA football officials during international championships

- IBSA Referee Coordinator.
- IBSA referees: as many ITOs as the number of participating teams + four NTOs.
- Referee kits including 2 different colour referee jerseys, 1 pair of referee shorts, 2 pairs of referee socks, 2 casual t-shirts, sports track suit, sports bag, and optional sports shoes.
- Free laundry.
- Per diem (to be agreed between LOC and IBSA), in addition to travel/visa expenses and full board accommodation.
- The appointments should be made 2 months prior to arrival day.
- Flight tickets should be sent electronically 45 days prior to arrival day, in order for officials to arrange leave from employment. Accreditation cards should also be received 45 days in advance.
- A room available for technical meetings, including 1 day fully-equipped for multimedia presentations.
- A changing room at the pitch with at least basic facilities (shower, table, chairs, keys to lock the door).
- Fully-equipped secretary desk for filling in score sheets, measuring time and substitutions process.
- Three days in advance arrival at the venue, taking into consideration that one day off should be scheduled for the referees.
